Treasurer Report FY 2026 - Lisa Truchon

Reporting Period: Through March 1, 2026

1. Summary

As of March 1, the association is maintaining a near-balanced budget, with a slight temporary deficit primarily due to timing in revenue booking for the first two months of the calendar year.

- **Total Revenues:** \$60,538.23
- **Total Expenses:** \$61,234.53
- **Net Position:** **(\$696.30)**

2. Revenue Breakdown

The State Education Grant remains our largest funding source, followed by Education registration fees.
